

Fully funded training available from York College – Offer for Schools

We currently have a list of 34 fully funded level 2 courses under the Adult Education Budget that we want to offer to York schools. These courses are fully accredited by the awarding body TQUK. To be eligible you need to be aged 19. There is no cost to the learner for these.

Online distance learning is a way of learning remotely without attending lessons in a classroom or having regular face-to-face contact with a tutor. This means you can study at work, on the go or in your own home, at a time that suits you, with the freedom to revisit areas of the course as little or as much as you like. Courses range from 6 to 12 weeks.

All these courses are available as Online learning this is a great way to achieve desirable qualifications while studying at a time and pace that suits you. The fully online learning courses range from 6 to 12 weeks in duration and will provide you with a Level 2 qualification in your chosen subject.

This can be as part of continuing professional development (CPD) so improving your professional skills and moving towards higher standards of professional practice to wanting to gain knowledge from an interest in your chosen subject area.

It is a roll on roll off programme so we can bespoke the enrolment to the school or university (numbers depending) myself and the team can attend the establishment to do the enrolment at a time that suites. For smaller numbers we have enrolments dates already in place and we can enrol these via email as quickly as the **12/04/2022**.

We have a bespoke online platform that all learning will be completed and a demo can be provided.

As part of your online distance learning programme, you will be provided with all of the support required to ensure your learning is successful. This includes an assessor who will review your assessments and feedback to you on an ongoing basis. We also have fully dedicated Online Distance Learning Team who can support in all aspects of your learning journey. We can also offer a text book (additional cost) that can be posted to the workplace or home.
