### **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

#### COMPOSITION

At least three members of the governing body with voting rights.

#### QUORUM

The quorum for a meeting and any vote will be three governors who are members of the committee.

# SLT Responsibility: Headteacher, Deputy Headteachers and Assistant Headteachers with responsibility for student progress

- 1. To establish the principles which underpin the school's Behaviour Policy;
- 2. To monitor and evaluate the implementation of the school's Behaviour Policy;
- To monitor and evaluate all matters relating to student performance including: academic attainment & progress; attendance; with special regard to specific cohorts, including students who attract the Pupil Premium (CLA, FSM & MOD); students who enter the school with low attainment in Literacy and Numeracy; and students with SEND;
- 4. To monitor and evaluate the data regarding: fixed term & permanent exclusions; managed moves; appeals; the Isolation Unit and attendance;
- To monitor and evaluate the implementation of all policy issues relating to Special Educational Need and Disabilities (SEND): Access Plan, SEND Offer and Policy and Medical Needs;
- 6. To monitor and evaluate the implementation of all policies regarding the Safeguarding of students: this includes all safeguarding, child protection, photo permissions etc.;
- 7. To monitor and evaluate the implementation of all policies relating to equality and diversity;
- 8. The review of and recommendations for the School Development Plan;
- 9. To monitor and evaluate the on-going development of the Student Progress and Pastoral systems.
- 10. To review student destinations.
- 11. To review student retention.
- 12. To contribute to the processes around Risk Management by identifying and/or monitoring those perceived risks identified to be linked to the student performance side of the school.
