

# CC Student app walk through

In this video I'm going to show you some of the main functions in the class charts student app.

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Now I'm using the website version here which you can log into using your pupil code and I'm going to show you the functions on here.

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But it behaves very similarly if you are using the app on your mobile phone.

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So to login you need your pupil code which should have been given to you by your phone tutor.

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So when you go to there you can click login and it will take you in to your specific pupil area.

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The code is specific to you so with the correct code you will be able to see all your information.

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So as you can see from here there is a little menu down the side on the app.

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It is across the top, but it has the same sections that you can look at.

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So you've got the behaviour sections.

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This shows you all your behaviour points, both positive and negative, in different forms.

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So at the minute this is showing the most recent month.

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You can change that if you want to and you can see the different points you've got.

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You can also see any activity towards the bottom.

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If there were negatives, for example, you'd be able to see any detentions and things like that.

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And that changes whenever anything's put onto the system.

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The next one you've got is your announcement section.

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So your announcement section is where you might see any letters that have been that have been sent home for you to look at or any potential announcements from for example, the house teams or pastoral teams or anybody who might want to send you a notification.

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It does get a little BLOB next to it to say there's something new there if you were to look for it.

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But they will, they will appear here.

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Some of them will stay permanently and some of them will will expire after a certain amount of time when they're no longer relevant.

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In here.

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You will be able to see under here where my mouse is a copy of your timetable and you can flick through the days and see the different elements of your timetable.

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Obviously my demo student doesn't have a timetable, but that will appear here and it will tell you what lessons you've got on any given day and you can obviously change the date here to a different date to see whichever day of the week you need.

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You'll also be able to see your attendance.

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Again, obviously this is my demo student, they haven't been in school.

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You'll be able to see what you've been marked for each day of the week.

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So you've got present, authorised absence or late or unauthorised absence and they will sit in here with the different coloured blocks.

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She'll be able to see that again.

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You can customise that to say how long you want to see on that particular chart.

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At the minute, that's got quite a lot of days.

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You could reduce it down to a week if you wanted to.

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And then towards the bottom we've got the rewards section.

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So what this will do is you'll be able to trade your reward points, so your positive points for different things within the reward store.

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Now this is still in the process of being built, but at the moment you can see there's some things like an early lunch pass and some charitable donations and a Vue Cinema voucher in there.

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When you meet the threshold for any of these particular things with the number of points that you've got, you can click purchase and they will be delivered to you at a certain time in the week in your form time.

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So you can purchase those using either the app or the website using the points that you have amassed from positive comments.

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And then at the bottom here, there is the badges section.

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Now this is where you can collect particular badges for certain things.

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So for example, this example here is the ICT Superstars.

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And there's a certain threshold for positive points in your ICT lessons that have triggered this particular badge.

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So they will be set up for you in the first few weeks of half term.

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So this is what you can what you can expect to see when you set up your class charts pupil app.
